  - This application would check the users entered SQL to make sure it was valid. It would then go through an approval process to let the managers know there was a statement needing approval. It then kept a historical record for each user's submission where they could read, update or remove the statement from running.
  - Built the program to run the SQL statements submitted by users.
- Took part in an Applications Development training in adopting NodeJS. Where everything from the basics to converting our web services over to using NodeJS on the iSeries was talked about.

  - Took over supply chain visibility integrations with 3rd party vendors.
